

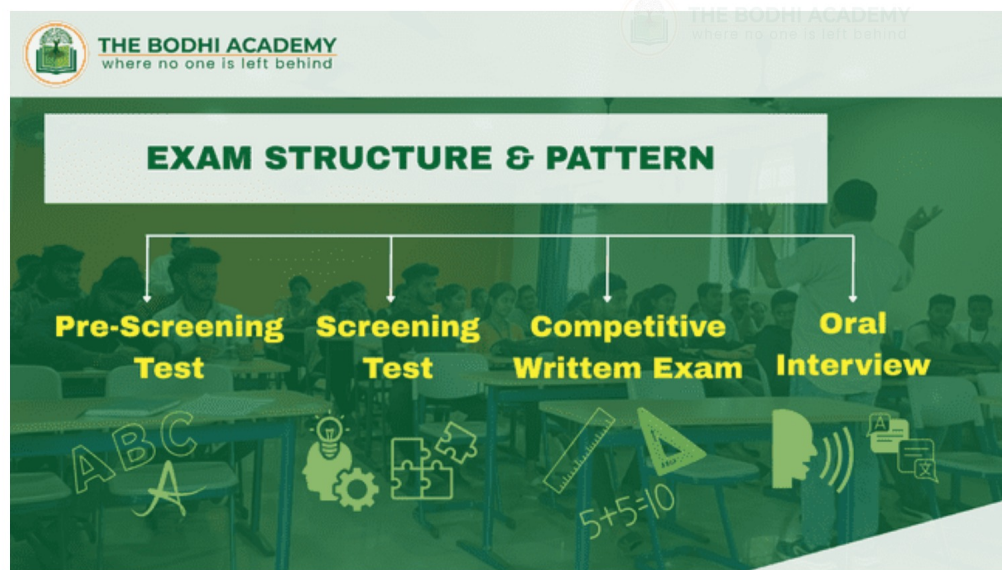

GPSC JSO Exam Pattern 2025 – Pre-Screening Test

To manage the large number of applicants efficiently, the Commission conducts an additional Pre-Screening Test before the main Screening Test. This stage acts as the first level of filtration in the GPSC JSO selection process.



GPSC JSO Exam Pattern - 250 Marks Competitive Written Exam

The exam is conducted in an Objective-type (MCQ) format, with each correct answer carrying +1 mark and no negative marking. It is held in multiple batches, and all papers are designed to maintain a uniform difficulty level.

- Total Questions: 60
- Total Marks: 60
- Duration for the exam: 75 Minutes

The exam primarily evaluates Reasoning, Numerical Aptitude, and English Comprehension, distributed as follows:

Section	Marks
General Intelligence, Reasoning & Numerical Aptitude	50
English Comprehension	10

Candidates need to score the prescribed minimum qualifying marks in the Pre-Screening Test to move to the next stage.

To provide a fair opportunity to borderline candidates, the Commission also conducts a Repeat Pre-Screening Test within two weeks of the first attempt.

Who is eligible for the Repeat Test?

Candidates who score within the repeat test range in their first attempt become eligible to appear for the Repeat Test. The eligibility criteria are 36–38 marks for UR/EWS, 33–35 marks for PwD/CFF/OBC, and 30–32 marks for SC/ST categories. There is no need for candidates to reapply, as GPSC will directly notify eligible students through email and SMS. The syllabus for the Repeat Test will remain the same as the initial Pre-Screening Test.

GPSC JSO Exam Pattern 2025 – Screening Test (CBRT)

Candidates qualifying the Pre-Screening stage, whether in the first or repeat attempt, are shortlisted for the Screening Test conducted through a Computer-Based Recruitment Test (CBRT). The exam features multiple-choice questions (MCQs).

- Total Marks: 75
- Duration for the exam: 90 Minutes

To qualify in the Screening Test, candidates must secure the minimum marks set for their category as per the GPSC JSO Exam Pattern. Only those meeting or exceeding these marks will proceed to the Competitive Written Examination. With the first stage clear, let's move to the Written Exam..

GPSC JSO Exam Pattern 2025 – Competitive Written Examination

With the initial stage cleared, we now move to the main phase. As per the GPSC JSO Exam Pattern, qualified candidates appear for the 250-mark Written Exam. This stage tests aptitude, governance awareness, analytical skills, and general knowledge.

The Written Examination consists of four parts, as detailed below:

Part A	General Intelligence, Reasoning & Numerical Aptitude	50	60 mins
Part B	Basics of the Constitution of India, Governance & Administration	75	120 mins
Part C	General Knowledge & Current Affairs	75	120 mins
Part D	English Comprehension	50	90 mins

To pass the Written Exam, candidates need to achieve the minimum qualifying percentage as per their category. The minimum percentage for qualifying is mentioned below:

- **UR / EWS:** 65%
- **PwD / CFF / OBC:** 60%
- **SC / ST:** 55%

GPSC JSO Exam Pattern 2025 – Oral Interview

The final stage of the GPSC JSO selection process is the Oral Interview, carrying 40 marks. As per the GPSC JSO Exam Pattern, only candidates who clear the Competitive Written Examination are invited to this round.

To qualify for the Oral Interview, candidates must secure a minimum of 50% marks. However, final selection is based on the combined score of the Written Exam and Interview, and candidates must also meet the overall minimum qualifying criteria listed below:

Category	Minimum Combined Percentage
UR / EWS	65%
PwD / CFF / OBC	60%
SC / ST	55%

The final merit list is created by combining the marks scored in both the Competitive Written Examination and the Oral Interview, while also adhering to reservation policies and official guidelines.

All shortlisted candidates will receive their call letters and hall tickets via email, along with detailed instructions for the interview process. - The **Competitive Written Examination** carries 250 marks in total, divided into four sections with individual weightages as prescribed by the Commission.
