The exam is conducted in two stages of Computer Based Test (CBT) – CBT-I (Screening Test) and CBT-II (Main Examination). CBT-I is qualifying in nature, while CBT-II carries weightage for final merit. A clear understanding of the Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern helps candidates focus on the right subjects and manage time better during preparation.

Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern 2025 – Stages

The Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern is conducted in two stages through a Computer Based Test (CBT). The first stage, CBT-I, acts as a screening test and is only qualifying in nature. The second stage, CBT-II, is the main examination that decides the final merit. A clear understanding of these stages helps candidates plan their preparation smartly.

Key Highlights of Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern

- The exam consists of objective type multiple-choice questions.
- No negative marking is applied.
- Minimum Qualifying Marks:
 - General: 45%
 - OBC/PwD: 40%
 - SC/ST: 35%
- Konkani Language Test is mandatory – candidates must score at least 4 marks.
- Candidates with PwD eligibility will get extra 20 minutes in the exam.

Syllabus Overview (As per Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern)

The syllabus under the Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern includes:

- Reasoning Ability – Series, Coding-Decoding, Puzzles, Logical Thinking
- Mathematics – Arithmetic, Algebra, Geometry, Data Interpretation
- English & Comprehension – Grammar, Vocabulary, Reading, Error Detection
- Konkani Language – Grammar, Vocabulary, Sentence Structure
- Technical Subjects (CBT-II) – Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Computer Science & IT fundamentals depending on the post applied

Preparation Tips for Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam

1. Understand the Exam Pattern thoroughly before starting preparation.
2. Focus on core engineering subjects for CBT-II as it decides final merit.
3. Practice mock tests and previous papers based on the Goa SSC Junior Engineer Exam Pattern.
4. Work on time management – CBTs are time-bound with high competition.
5. Do not neglect the Konkani Language section as it is mandatory.

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
